

CITY OF GALVESTON HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Sullivan Land Services was one of 4 contractors chosen to participate in the rebuilding effort of the City of Galveston following the devastation of Hurricane Ike in 2008. SLS worked with the project administrator and Harris County to provide qualified residents with a new or refurbished home. During the course of the project, an estimated 600 homes will be rebuilt or repaired by Sullivan Land Services.

SLS designed and constructed homes within various size ranges, developed interior finish packages and worked with clients during Benefits Selection process. When working with refurbished homes, SLS had unique challenges to determine the capability and process to take the home from the current grade to the approved Base Flood Elevation, which often required that the home be lifted 10-15 feet and placed on piling.
