

COASTAL RIGHT-OF-WAY CLEANUP (SEPTEMBER 2008 – NOVEMBER 2008)

This project was performed for Galveston County and the City of Galveston on over 150 miles of county and city rights-of-way. SLS, acting as prime subcontractor under CrowderGulf and DRC, was responsible for the removal of over 500,000 cubic yards of debris and sand. Multiple agencies such as FEMA, TXDOT, GLO, Galveston County, City of Galveston and Beck were involved in the project and provided oversight to ensure that FEMA-325 debris management standards were followed to at all times.

SLS self-performed approximately 80% of the project and utilized over 40 personnel and 30 pieces of equipment, including excavators, bulldozers, skid steers, trucks (on-road & articulated off-road), screen plants and loaders.

The job was completed ahead of schedule and allowed for the efficient re-opening and use of many city and county roads following Hurricane Ike.
