

DOLPHIN INSTALLATION PROJECT

Sullivan Land Services, LTD was hired by Texas International Terminals in Galveston, Texas to improve safe berths at all docking slips. Safety improvements included repairing and replacing deteriorated and under-sized dolphins and cleats on the deep water berth, barge dock and tee head. SLS also cleaned, coated and painted all existing dock dolphins and cleats, in addition to repairing the barge dock bulkhead.

Equipment used on this project included a vibro, trackhoe, sand blaster, industrial coating sprayer, welders, 4600 Mantiwoocs and multiple T&T salvage divers. More than 3000 linear feet of pipe, 300 cubic yards of aggregate, 200 gallons of coating, 3,000 pounds of sand blast grit and 300 square feet of steel plate were also employed.

This installation project was initiated in early December 2009 and is expected to be complete by end of February 2009, with 1,800 man-hours to date.
