

EVIA COMMUNITY SITE DEVELOPMENT

Sullivan Land Services planned, executed and completed the site development for Evia, a residential community in Galveston, Texas. The total site of 93 acres required the infrastructure design and installation of water, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, electrical, gas and telephone/cable systems as well as the design and completion of all roadways, parks and sidewalks.

The entire project was completed in 9 months and SLS moved 700,000 cubic yard of material. In addition to installing miles of rods and pipes, SLS completed the community by grading all of the material to produce 388 lots, a 15 acre lake and retention basin, 5 acre wetland habitat and 30 acres of parks in this traditional neighborhood development.
