

## FEMA COMMUNITY HOUSING SITES (FEBRUARY 2009 – MARCH 2009)

This project was performed for FEMA and involved the development of two emergency housing community sites on Galveston Island and High Island (Bolivar Peninsula). SLS, acting as prime subcontractor under CH2MHILL, was responsible for the complete and simultaneous development of the two communities, which included site work and infrastructure construction as well as the transport, installation and make-ready of 106 temporary housing units.

Both projects were completed simultaneously in a very fast-paced 28 days, utilizing over 150 personnel and 200 pieces of earthwork, transport and unit setting equipment.

SLS self-performed approximately 70% of the project and worked primarily with FEMA and USACE personnel throughout the job.

- Construction and completion of 2 THU sites on Galveston Island and Bolivar Peninsula
- Coordinated total site and infrastructure construction for the placement of 106 THUs
- Both sites completed simultaneously in 28 days
