

SITE DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF GALVESTON BAY BIODIESEL

Sullivan Land Services, Ltd. was employed to reclaim and stabilize 6 acres of property covered with 100,000 CY of silty dredge spoils. While the property was not contaminated, the spoils were very poor and were the consistency of toothpaste.

SLS removed the soil and imported over 150,000 CY of structural fill for the property which was required to build the liquid storage tank foundations. SLS also installed drainage structures, ditches, aggregate, board roads and tank foundations.
