

## TEXAS BEACH RESTORATION (NOVEMBER 2008 – MARCH 2009)

This project was performed for the Texas General Land Office on 60+ miles of beaches located on Galveston Island, Bolivar Peninsula and Brazoria County. SLS, acting as prime subcontractor under CrowderGulf, was responsible for debris removal and the screening and replacement of over 1.5 million cubic yards of beach sand following Hurricane Ike.

Over 120 personnel and 85 pieces of equipment, including excavators, bulldozers, screen plants and trucks (on-road & articulated off-road) were coordinated for the project. SLS self-performed 90% of the project and was required to adhere to FEMA-325 debris management standards throughout the entire project.

Additionally, SLS worked with numerous regulatory and monitoring agencies, including FEMA, TX-GLO, HNTB and Neil Schaeffer. The project value was approximately \$14.0 million.
