

## CANADIAN EMBASSY RECONSTRUCTION IN HAITI

Responsible for the transocean transportation, delivery and installation of modular housing units to reconstruct the Canadian Embassy in Port Au Prince, Haiti following the devastating earthquake in 2010.

Specific challenges included the transocean transportation coordination, debarkation point in Haiti due to the inaccessibility of the port facilities, location and coordination of qualified local personnel to perform the required functions and specific logistical challenges due to the lingering effects of the earthquake.

SLS personnel provided all technical and equipment support and also employed over 30 Haitians during the project. This was done in an effort to help Haitians recover financially from their loss.

### PROJECT SUMMARY

- 46 containers, housing 75 people moved and placed
- Due to overwhelming congestion problems during the day and other logistical issues, 50% of the work had to be performed during the nighttime hours.
- Material and supply availability was a major challenge.
