

SCHOLES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – MAIN TERMINAL

Sullivan Land Services demolished and rebuilt the main airport terminal building at Scholes International Airport for The Texas Department of Transportation.

The facility had been destroyed during Hurricane Ike in 2008. The main terminal building is approximately 5,000 sq. ft and houses the main waiting areas, VIP lounge, pilot waiting area and storage facilities for the airport.

Scholes International Airport serves as the main terminal facility for all offshore transportation aircraft as well as private aircraft arriving and departing Galveston Island.
